Welcome Address by Regional Director:

Dr. M.S. Parthasaraty, and Dr. D.R. Sharma, Sr. Regional Directors, extended warm welcome to all the dignitaries from IGNOU Hqrts. Honourable Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Nageshwar Rao, Respected Director, Regional Services Division, Dr. Shrikanth Mahapatra, Respected Director, Campus Placement Cell, Dr. Rupam, Dr. Hema Pant, Deputy Director, Regional Services Division, Coordinators & PICs and Alumni.

Dr. D.R. Sharma, Sr. Regional Director, Regional Centre, Pune presented a brief progress report of the Regional Centre on admission, the promotional activities undertaken and the enrollment figures of the recent admission session. Suggestions by Alumni

- Provide merit scholarship from IGNOU for visual impaired students;
- Common contact point for students should be provided;
- Recognition of IGNOU Programmes questioned by other institutions, industries etc.;
- Encouragement for online student support services: Assignment, Practical and Project submission, etc.;
- Syllabus should contain practical components;
- Evaluation system should contain third party evaluation;

The Vice-Chancellor, Director, RSD and Director CPC responded to queries related to recognition of IGNOU Programmes, translation of SLM to regional languages, etc.

During the feedback session, many have expressed to be proud to be an IGNOU Alumni and are eager to provide all necessary support.

Dr. R.M. Yellatti, Coordinator, IGNOU Study Centre: 16138, Sangli said that the Study Centre was activated in the year 2014 and has 19 programme activated. Study Centre is promoting programmes in the region and encouraging the transgender community and Self Help Groups (SHGs) to join admission to IGNOU programme.
